

A Mail-In Ballot's Journey



Ballots are Designed and Printed

Ballots are prepared and mailed via First Class Mail to voters with active requests



Voter completes and returns the ballot in the mail, secure drop box or in person to the Board of Elections

Board of Elections enters ballots as received into the system and sorts them



Each signature is verified

Voter's information is separated from voted ballot to protect privacy.



Voters with signature issues on their Certificates can "Cure Their Ballot"



Ballots are removed from the envelopes before Election Day by teams of 2 consisting of a Republican & Democrat



Ballots are fed through a machine which tallies the votes. This process is open to the public!



The Unofficial Vote by Mail Results are integrated with Election Day Machine and Early Voting Results and posted on our website on Election Night.



The Board continues to receive timely ballots 6 days after the election, if they were postmarked by election day. They continue to count cured ballots until the Cure Letters are due.



The Clerk's Office will post updated results until all timely & valid votes have been counted.



All Results including Vote by Mail Votes are Certified as Official 13 Days after the Election
